BY THE GOVERNOR IN THE PRIVY COUNCIL OF NORTHERN IRELAND.

ABERCORN.

WHEREAS it is provided by the Local Government (Postponement of Elections) Act (Northern Ireland), 1937, that as respects the year nineteen hundred and thirty-seven in the case of the council of any borough or other urban district, or the commissioners of any town, the ordinary day of election of aldermen, councillors, or commissioners should be postponed from the fifteenth day of May to such day, not later than the first day of December in the said year, as the Governor of Northern Ireland may by Order in the Privy Council of Northern Ireland appoint.

And whereas it is further provided by the said Act that such Order in Council shall as respects any case in which the election day is postponed by virtue of the said Act, appoint the several days referred to in subsection two of section one of the said Act.

Now, therefore, I, James Albert Edward, Duke of Abercorn, Knight of the Most Noble Order of the Garter, Knight of the Most Illustrious Order of Saint Patrick, Governor of Northern Ireland, by and with the advice of the Privy Council of Northern Ireland, in exercise of the powers vested in me by the Local Government (Postponement of Elections) Act (Northern Ireland), 1937, and of all other powers enabling me in that behalf, do hereby order as follows:

1. This Order may be cited as the Local Government (Postponement of Elections) Order, 1937.

- 2. As respects the year nineteen hundred and thirty-seven in the case of the council of any borough or other urban district, or the commissioners of any town, the ordinary day of election of aldermen, councillors, or commissioners shall be the fifteenth day of October in the said year.
- 3. As respects any case in which the election day is postponed by virtue of the said Act, the following days are hereby appointed, that is to say:—
 - (a) In the case of the council of an district other than urban borough, and of the commissioners of a town, the day of the annual meeting and ordinary day of election of the chairman and vice-chairman of the council or commissioners, shall be the twenty-third day of October, or such day not more than three days earlier or later than that day, as the council or town commissioners may at a previous meeting decide;
 - (b) In the case of the council of a borough, the day on which the quarterly meeting next after the election day shall be the twenty-third day of October, or such day not more than three days earlier or later than that day as the council may at a previous meeting decide;
 - (c) In a borough the ordinary day of retirement of the mayor, including, in the county borough of
