

WIDOWS', ORPHANS' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT, 1936.

KING'S BENCH DIVISION--IN BANKRUPTCY
HERBERT McCORMICK, of 359-363 North Queen Street, and 66 University Street, in the County of the City of Belfast, Automobile Engineer and Oil Salesman, was on the 16th day of September, 1937, adjudged Bankrupt.
