WIDOWS,' ORPHANS,' AND OLD AGE CONTRIBUTORY PENSIONS ACT, 1936.

NOTICE is hereby given under section 168 of the National Health Insurance Act, 1936, that it is proposed by the National Health Insurance Joint Committee, the Minister of Health and the Department of Health for Scotland, acting jointly, in conjunction with the Treasury and after consultation with the Board of Trade, after the expiration of at least 21 days from this date, in exercise of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Widows,' Orphans' and

Old Age Contributory Pensions Act, 1936, and of all other powers enabling them in that behalf, to make a special order to be entitled the Contributory Pensions (Mercantile Marine) Order, 1937.
