KING'S BENCH DIVISION—IN BANKRUPTCY

JOHN JAMES DOHERTY, formerly of 15 Richmond Street, and now residing at 36 Argyle Street, both in the City of Londonderry, Tobacconist, was on the 20th day of December, 1937, adjudged Bankrupt.

PUBLIC SITTINGS will be held before the Court at the Royal Courts of Justice (Ulster), Belfast, on Friday, the 28th day of January, 1938, and on Friday, the 4th day of February, 1938, at the hour of Eleven o'clock in the forenoon, whereat the Bankrupt is to attend, and to make a full disclosure and discovery of his Estate and Effects.
