REGULATIONS, 1938.

Notice is hereby given that the Ministry of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, under the powers conferred on it by the Motor Vehicles and Road Traffic Acts (Northern Ireland), 1926 to 1934, has made Regulations dated the 3rd day of February,

1938, entitled The Motor Cars (Speed) Regulations, 1938.

The Regulations amend the Motor Cars (Speed) Regulations, 1935, as regards speed limits for certain goods vehicles.
