MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS FOR NORTHERN IRELAND. EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

Whereas Sergeant William McAndrew (No. 1725) of the Royal Ulster Constabulary was, on the 8th day of December, 1936, appointed to be an Inspector for Northern Ireland under the Explosives Act, 1875:

And whereas the said Sergeant William McAndrew is no longer available for the duties of Inspector:

Now I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, being the Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, in virtue of the power conferred on me by Section 53 of the said Act, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, do hereby order that the said Sergeant William McAndrew shall from this date cease to exercise the powers and perform the duties of an Inspector under the said Act.

EXPLOSIVES ACT, 1875.

In virtue of the power conferred on me by Section 53 of the Explosives Act, 1875, and of every other power enabling me in this behalf, I, the Right Honourable Sir Richard Dawson Bates, being the Minister of Home Affairs for Northern Ireland, hereby appoint Sergeant Evelyn Ferguson (No. 2805), of the Royal Ulster Constabulary, as an Inspector for Northern Ireland under the said Act, and do hereby direct him to exercise only such powers and to perform such duties under the said Act as I shall from time to time assign to him.

MARKETING OF EGGS (DETERMINATION OF WHOLESALE DEALERS' PRICES) (No. 40) ORDER (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1938.

Notice is hereby given that an Order has been made by the Ministry of Agriculture determining that the prices payable by licensed wholesale dealers for eggs delivered during the week ended Saturday, 8th October, 1938, shall be as follows:—

(a) (i) For hen eggs purchased from a producer, 11²/₄d. per lb.

Where the eggs were delivered by the vendor to premises used by a licensed wholesale dealer of Class A for the testing, grading, and packing of eggs, or to a collecting depot specified in the schedule to the above-mentioned Order, an additional halfpenny per lb. shall be paid.
