

after making certain devises and bequests, she directed that the residue and remainder of her estate should be sold and converted into money, and that the proceeds thereof should be divided into three equal parts. And testatrix further directed, inter alia, as follows:—

(a) As to one of said third parts to pay the same to the Secretary or Treasurer for the time being of the Irish Mission of the Reformed Presbyterian Church in Ireland.

(b) As to one other of said third parts to pay the same to the Secretary or Treasurer for the time being of the Mission to Lepers.

The testatrix died on the 27th day of October,

1939, and Probate of her said Will and Codicil was, on the 12th day of December, 1939, granted forth of the Principal Registry, King's Bench Division (Probate) of the High Court of Justice in Northern Ireland to Robert Scott, of 250 Old Lodge Road, Belfast, Gentleman, being the Executor therein named.
