## CERTIFICATE

OF SUMS PAYABLE TO LOCAL AUTHORITIES OUT OF MONEYS PROVIDED BY PARLIAMENT PURSUANT TO THE PROVISIONS OF SECTION 10 OF THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT (NORTHERN IRELAND), 1923, AS AMENDED BY SUBSEQUENT ENACTMENTS.

Pursuant to the provisions of sub-section 1 of Section 2 of the Local Government (Financial Provisions) Act (Northern Ireland), 1924, Section 10 of the Economy (Exchequer Relief) Act (Northern Ireland), 1926, Section 10 of the Local Government (Rating and Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1929, Section 1 of the Local Government (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1936, Section 1 of the Local Government (Finance) Act (Northern Ireland), 1940, and the Regulations made thereunder by the Ministry of Home Affairs on the 2nd day of June, 1927, with the approval of the Ministry of Finance; the Ministry of Home Affairs hereby certifies

the sums specified in Column 2 of the enclosure to this certificate to be the sums payable annually out of moneys provided by Parliament and out of the Road Fund (Northern Ireland) in accordance with the said Section 10 of the Local Government Act (N.I.), 1923, as amended, to each Local Authority named in Column 1 of the said enclosure as being the equivalent of the average of the payments made out of the Local Taxation (Ireland) Account in or in respect of the three financial years ended on the 31st day of March, 1918, 31st day of March, 1919, and the 31st day of March, 1920.

The certificate issued by the Ministry of Home Affairs on the 13th day of June, 1938, is hereby cancelled.
