This day, Baron Silverhjelm, Minister Resident from the King of Sweden, had a private audience of his Majesty, in which he delivered his new credentials, giving him the character of Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from Sweden;

To which he was introduced by the Right Hon. Lord Hawkesbury, his Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, and conducted by Sir Stephen Cottrell, Kt. Master of the Ceremonies.

The King was this day pleased to confer the honour of Knighthood on Major Charles Holloway of the Royal Engineers.

The King has been pleased to order a Conge d'Elire to pass the Great Seal of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, empowering the Dean and Chapter of the Cathedral Church of Bristol to elect a Bishop of that See; the same being void by the translation of the Right Reverend Father in God Folliot Hertbert Walker, late Bishop thereof, to the See of Hereford: And his Majesty has also been pleased to recommend the Hon. and Rev. George P. Iham, Doctor in Divinity, to be by them elected Bishop of the said See of Bristol.
