The following address has been presented to the King; which his Majesty was pleafed o receive very gracioufly :

To the King's Most Excellent Majesty, The humble Address of the Noblemen, Freeholders, and Heritors of the County of Edinburgh.

Most Gracicus Sovereign,

E, your Majesty's most dutiful and loyal Subjects, the Noblemen, Freebolders, and Heritors of the County of Edinbergh, beg leave to approach your Throne with our unfeigned congratulations on the providential discovery and defeat of the late, traitorous confeiracy against your Royal Person and Govern-

Deeply impressed with sentiments of affectionere regard to your Majest'r for the bleifings we enjoy under your mild and equitable Government, and tentible of the invaluable benefits, we derive from our excellent Constitution, we beheld with harror and deteffation the base and nefarious plan for involving in one common destruction the obects of our dearest interest, the life of our Granous Sovereign, and the stability of our Constitu-

Anxious for the welfare and fecurity of our country, which is most closely connected with your Majesty's personal safety, we avail ourfelves of this opportunity of renewing our expreftions of fincere attachment and ardent affection to your Majesty's person; and we hope that the people of these realms, living under your Marasty's parental care, may long possess the comforts and blessings they have hitherto enjoyed.
