(PLEURO-PNEUMONIA.)

By the Board of Agriculture.

The Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1890, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do order, and it is hereby ordered, as follows:—

1. The following Place (namely)—the land and premises at Castle Farm, Stewarton, in the County of Ayr, in the occupation of Mr. Gabriel Dunlop, which was declared by Order of the Board, dated the sixth day of February one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one, to be a Place infected with pleuro-pneumonia, is hereby declared to be free from pleuro-pneumonia, and that Place shall, as from the commencement of this Order, cease to be a Place infected with pleuro-pneumonia.

2. This Order shall take effect from and immediately after the fourteenth day of March one thousand eight hundred and ninety-one.

The Board of Agriculture, by virtue and in exercise of the powers in them vested under The Board of Agriculture Act, 1889, and The Contagious Diseases (Animals) Acts, 1878 to 1890, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do hereby revoke their Order, bearing date the ninth day of December one thousand eight hundred and ninety, prohibiting the conveyance to or from any port in England or Wales or Scotland of cattle, sheep, and swine taken on board for the purpose of importation in or on the steamship *Princess Alexandra*, registered at the port of Glasgow, official number 20677, owned by Messrs. J. & P. Hutchinson, of Glasgow: Provided that nothing herein shall be deemed to invalidate or make unlawful anything done under the said Order before the date of this revocation, or interfere with the institution or prosecution of any proceeding in respect of any offence committed against, or any penalty incurred under, the said Order.
