12	Hill of Fearn	and Balintore, then in a south-easterly direction along the centre of the last-mentioned road and across the road from Hilton of Cadboll to Nigg and along the eastern march of Balintore farm to the sea.
13	Nigg	The remainder of the Parish of Fearn.
14	Logie-Easter	The Parish of Nigg.
15	Kilmuir-Easter	The Parish of Logie-Easter.
16	Rosskeen South	The Parish of Kilmuir-Easter.
17	Rosskeen North	That part of the Parish of Rosskeen (exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the Police Burgh of Invergordon) which lies between the Cromarty Firth and a line drawn in a generally westerly direction along the centre of the main road from Tain to Dingwall from the point at which the said road enters the Parish to the point at the east end of the village of Bridgend of Alness at which a side road strikes off in a northerly direction to Crosshills, thence along the last-mentioned road first in a northerly and then in a westerly direction till it joins the main road leading from Bridgend of Alness to Ardross at a point south of Crosshills, and thence due west to the parish boundary.
18	Invergordon	The remainder of the Parish of Rosskeen, exclusive of the portion included within the limits of the Police Burgh of Invergordon.
19	Barvas North	The Police Burgh of Invergordon.
20	Barvas South	III. LEWS DISTRICT.
21	Uig East	That part of the Parish of Barvas which lies to the north and east of a line drawn in a generally south-easterly direction from the point between Five-penny Borge and Lower Shader at which Allt Mhiosgro falls into the sea, up the said Allt to the point at which it flows out of Loch Marabhat, and thence direct to the point at which the Gress river crosses the boundary between the Parishes of Barvas and Stornoway.
22	Uig West	The remainder of the Parish of Barvas.
23	Lochs	That part of the Parish of Uig which lies to the east of a line drawn in a generally southerly direction from the open sea at the northmost point of East Loch Roag along the centre of the said loch by the east of Ceabhadh and of Eilean Chearstaidh through Loch Ceann Thulabhig to the point at which Amhuinn Ghrimersta enters it, and thence up the said river and through the following lochs and their connecting streams, viz.:—Loch Faoghail-an-Tuim, Loch Faoghail Charrasan, Loch Faoghail Chircabhal, Loch Airdh-nah-Airde, Loch Faoghail nan Caorach, and Loch Langabhat, till it meets the boundary of the Parish.
24	Park	The remainder of the Parish of Uig, including the Flannan Islands.
25	Back	That part of the Parish of Lochs which lies to the north and east of a line drawn from the open sea at the mouth of Loch Erisort in a westerly direction along the centre of the said loch by the north of Tabhaid Mhor to a point opposite the mouth of the river Laxay, thence to and up the centre of the said river to the point at which it leaves Loch Nam Faileag, and thence through the last-mentioned loch and Loch Threalabhall to the boundary of the parish at the north end of the last-mentioned loch.
		The remainder of the Parish of Lochs.
		That part of the Parish of Stornoway which lies to the north of Broad Bay and of a line drawn in a generally westerly direction from the point at which Amhuinn-a-Ghlinn-Duibh enters the said bay up the said river to Lochmor-a-starr, thence through the said loch to its northmost point, and thence due north to the boundary of the parish.
