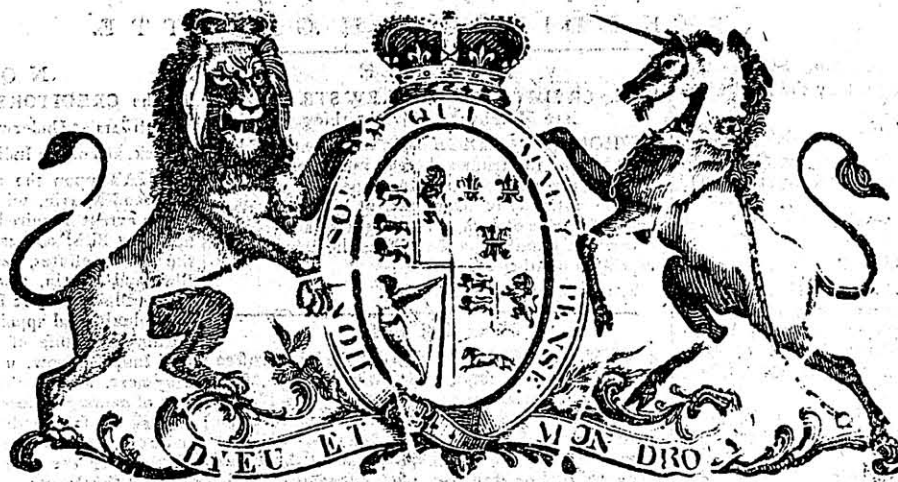

**WESTMINSTER, APRIL 22.**  
This day, the Lords being met, and the Commons having come, the royal assent, by commission, was given to the following bills, viz.

An act for raising the sum of 4 millions by loans or Exchequer bills for the service of the year 1803.

An act to enable his Majesty to grant a certain annuity to Rear Admiral Sir James Saumarez, Bart. K. B. in consideration of his eminent services, performed on various occasions.

An act to provide until the 25th March 1804, for the more speedy and effectual completion of the establishment of officers in the militia of Great Britain, and for facilitating the filling up of vacancies therein.—To three other public and three private acts.
