A PROCLAMATION.

VICTORIA, R.

WHEREAS Our Parliament stands prorogued to Thursday the twentieth day of December one thousand eight hundred and ninety-four; We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, hereby issue Our Royal Proclamation, and publish and declare that the said Parliament be further prorogued to Tuesday the fifth day of February one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five; and We do hereby further, with the advice aforesaid, declare Our Royal will and pleasure that the said Parliament shall, on the said Tuesday the fifth day of February one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five, assemble and be holden for the despatch of divers urgent and important affairs : and the Lords, Spiritual and Temporal, and the Knights, Citizens, and Burgesses, and the Commissioners for Shires and Burghs of the House of Commons, are hereby required and commanded to give their attendance accordingly at Westminster, on the said Tuesday the fifth day of February one thousand eight hundred and ninety-five.

PROPOSED ORDER No. I.

PARISHES OF FORFAR AND GLAMIS.

WHEREAS it has been represented to me by the Town Council of the Burgh of Forfar, and by the Parochial Board of the Parish of Forfar, and by the County Council of the County of Forfar, that I should issue an Order, under section 51 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1889, and section 46 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1894, detaching from the Parish of Glamis the portion thereof situated within the boundaries of the Burgh of Forfar, and attaching it to the Parish of Forfar ; and
