UNIVERSITIES (SCOTLAND) ACT, 1889.

ORDINANCE No. 144.

[GENERAL, No. 17.—SUPPLEMENTARY POWERS
OF UNIVERSITY COURT.]

At Edinburgh, the twenty-ninth day of March
eighteen hundred and ninety-five years.

WHEREAS by the Universities (Scotland) Act, 1889 (hereinafter referred to as the first-mentioned Act), the Commissioners under the said Act are empowered by section 14, sub-section 2, to regulate the powers, duties, jurisdictions, and privileges of, *inter alia*, the University Court, as well with respect to the government, policy, and discipline of the University as to the management and disposal of the revenues and endowments thereof:

And whereas by section 6 of the first-mentioned Act the University Court, in addition to the powers conferred upon it by the Universities (Scotland) Act, 1858, is empowered (sub-section 5), subject to any Ordinances made by the said Commissioners, to define, on application by any member of the Senatus Academicus, the nature and limits of a Professor's duties under his Commission, subject to appeal to the Universities Committee, and (sub-section 10) after the expira-
