WILD BIRDS PROTECTION ACTS, 1880 to 1894. COUNTY OF KIRKCUDBRIGHT.

ORDER by the Secretary for Scotland.

IN pursuance of the powers conferred upon me by the 'Wild Birds Protection Act, 1894,' and upon application by the County. Council of the County of Kirkcudbright, I, the Right Honourable Sir George Otto Trevelyan, Baronet, Her Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, do hereby make the following Orders :---

1. The taking or destroying the eggs of the following species of Wild Birds is prohibited throughout the entire County of Kirkcudbright for a period of one year from the 1st day of June 1895, viz. :—

Buzzard (Buteo vulgaris). Goldfinch (Carduelis elegans). Great Crested Grebe (Podicipes cristatus). Common Gull (Larus canus) Blackheaded Gull (Larus ridibundus). Kestrel (Falco tinnunculus). Kingfisher (Alcedo ispida). Barn Owl (Strix flammea). Tawny Owl (Syrnium aluco). Long-eared Owl (Asio otus). Short-eared Owl (Asio accipitrinus). Oyster Catcher (Hœmatopus ostralegus). Ringed Plover (Aegialitis hiaticula). Pochard (Fuligula ferina). Sheld-duck (Tadorna cornuta). Shoveller (Spatula clypeata). Great Spotted Woodpecker (Dendrocopus major). Crossbill (Loxia curvirostra). Dipper (Cinclus aquaticus). Siskin (Chrysomitris spinus). Skylark (Alauda arvensis). Tufted Duck (Fuligula cristata). Osprey (Pandion haliaëtus). Nightjar (Caprimulgus europœus). Chough (Pyrrhocorax graculus). Quail (Coturnix communis).
