

Gibraltar, and ports within the Straits, America, and West Indies, the toll of three-sixteenths of a penny per ton of the burden of every such ship in respect of each of the said lights known as the "Edinburgh Channel" and the "Black Deep," for every time of passing each of the said lights. Save and except that such Light Duties shall be payable once only in respect of the same voyage, if such voyage commences or terminates at a port within the following limits, that is to say, the coast of the United Kingdom, the Channel Islands, and the Isle of Man, and the Continent of Europe between the River Elbe and Brest inclusive.

Save as hereinbefore mentioned, the said tolls shall be levied subject to the regulations, exemptions, and abatements or discounts contained or referred to in the said New Consolidated Tables of Light Duties, or to such other regulations, exemptions, and abatements or discounts as may from time to time be duly sanctioned.
