I herewith transmit, for the information of my Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, a copy of my letter to Admiral Montagu, acquainting him of the capture of Le Hazard French privateer, by the brig I command.

In proceeding from Guernsey to this anchorage with the transports under convoy, having on board the 43d regiment, I vesterday, at seven A.M. Beachy bearing by compass E. by M. distant five leagues, sell in with, and, after a chase of four hours, captured Le Hazard lugger privateer of Boulogue, commanded by Pierre Francois Beauvois, mounting fix guns, (two of which were thrown overboard during the chase) with a complement of 34, men She sailed three days before from Dioppe; and late the preceding evening, off Newhaven, had captured the Jine, a sloop laden with merchandize, from Southempton bound to London.
