ACT OF ADJOURNAL RELATIVE TO

FINE OR IMPRISONMENT (SCOTLAND AND IRELAND) ACT, 1899.

At Edinburgh, the Twentieth day of March, in the year One Thousand Nine Hundred.

PRESENT,

The Lord Justice-General, Lord Justice-Clerk, and Lords Commissioners of Justiciary, Consider-ing that by Section One of the Fine or Imprisonment (Scotland and Ireland) Act, 1899, 62 and 63 Victoria, chapter 11, it is enacted "That where a " person is committed to prison for non-payment i

" of a sum adjudged to be paid by the conviction "of any Court of summary jurisdiction, then on "payment to the Governor of the Prison, under "conditions prescribed by prison rules, of any "sum in part satisfaction of the sum so adjudged "to be paid, and of any charges for which the "prisoner is liable, the term of imprisonment shall be reduced by a number of days bearing " as nearly as possible the same proportion to the " total number of days for which the prisoner is " sentenced, as the sum so paid bears to the sum " for which he is so liable"; and that by Section Two thereof it is enacted that " Provision may be " made by Act of Adjournal under Section Thirty-" three of the Summary Procedure Act, 1864, for "the application of sums paid under this Act, " and for any matter incidental thereto"; the said Lords do hereby ENACT and DECLARE-

- I. That all sums paid under Section One of the said Act 62 and 63 Victoria, chapter 11, shall be handed over on receipt by the Governor of the Prison, as defined in said Act, to the Clerk of the Court in which the conviction was obtained, and thereafter paid and applied, pro tanto, in the same manner and to the same purpose or purposes as sums heretofore adjudged to be paid by the conviction and sentence of the Court, and paid and recovered in terms thereof, have lawfully been paid and applied.
- II. This Act of Adjournal shall forthwith be published in Her Majesty's Edinburgh Gazette, and be printed and circulated among all concerned.
