IS Majesty, by His Royal Letter, having been pleased to appoint the Honourable Mr. Justice Ross to be of His Majesty's Most Honourable Privy Council in Ireland, he this day in Council took the usual Oaths and his place at the Board accordingly.

WHITEHALL, November 4, 1902.

The King has been pleased to give and grant unto William Ferdinand Tyler, Esq., Commander Imperial Chinese Navy, His Majesty's Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the distinction of the Peacock's Feather, and the Insignia of the First Class of the Third Division of the Imperial Chinese Order of the Double Dragon, conferred upon him by His Imperial Majesty the Emperor of China, in recognition of his services to His Imperial Majesty as Deputy Coast Inspector and Acting Harbour Master, Shanghai.

WHITEHALL, November 4, 1902.

The King has been pleased to give and grant unto Alexander Pope, Esq., His Majesty's Royal-licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Insignia of the Fifth Class of the Imperial Ottoman Order of the Medjidieh, conconferred upon him by His Highness the Khedive of Egypt, in recognition of his services to the Egyptian Government as Director of Prisons at Alexandria.

RAILWAY EMPLOYMENT (PREVEN-TION OF ACCIDENTS) ACT, 1900.

The Board of Trade give notice, pusuant to section 2 (1) of the above-mentioned Act, that they propose to make a Rule with respect to the subject of brake levers on both sides of waggons, being the first of the matters specified in the schedule to the above Act.
