MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903. BURGH OF POLLOKSHAWS.

NOTICE is hereby given that the Town Council of the Burgh of Pollokshaws have made application to the Secretary for Scotland praying that Regulations under section 9 (1) of the Motor Car Act should be made restricting the rate of speed for motor car traffic to ten miles an hour on all the highways within the limits of the Burgh.

Notice is hereby further given that the application may be inspected during office hours at the Office of the Town-Clerk in Pollokshaws, and that objections to the making of such Regulations may be sent in writing to the Secretary for Scotland at the Scottish Office, Whitehall, London, at any time within fourteen days of the date of publication of this advertisement. A copy of any such objection should be sent at the same time to the Town-Clerk.

MOTOR CAR ACT, 1903.

REGULATIONS UNDER SECTION 8.

THE MOTOR CARS (PROHIBITION ON SPECIAL ROADS) (COUNTY OF PERTH) ORDER, 1904.

TITTHEREAS by section 8 of the "Motor Car

HEREAS by section 8 of the "Motor Car Act, 1903," as read with the "Locomotives on Highways Act, 1896," it is provided that the Secretary for Scotland may, by Regulations made under section 6 of the second recited Act, prohibit or restrict the driving of any motor cars, or of any special kind of motor cars, on any specified highway, or part of a highway, which does not exceed sixteen feet in width, or on which ordinary motor car traffic would, in his opinion, be especially dangerous:

And whereas the County Council of the County of Perth, being the road authority of the said County, have represented to me that it is desirable to prohibit the driving of motor cars on certain public highways in the County of Perth:

And whereas I am of opinion that it is

And whereas I am of opinion that it is expedient to give effect to the said representation, so far as the highways hereinafter mentioned are concerned:

Now, therefore, in pursuance of the powers vested in me in that behalf, I, the undersigned, His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, do hereby make the following Regulations:—

- (1) No person shall cause or permit a motor car to be driven, or shall drive a motor car on, such part of the highways named in the first column of the Schedule to this Regulation, as is defined in the second column of the said Schedule.
- (2) This Order may be cited as "The Motor Cars (Prohibition on Special Roads) (County of Perth) Order, 1904," and shall have effect on and after the first day of September one thousand nine hundred and four.
