COUNTY COUNCIL ELECTORAL DIVISIONS OF BUTESHIRE.

WHEREAS by their Order dated 3rd July 1891, the Boundary Commissioners for Scotland determined the contents and boundaries of the Electoral Divisions of the County of Bute.
