Act, 1904," it is (among other things) enacted, that it shall be lawful for His Majesty, by Order in Council, to specify new fees to be paid in respect of the verification and stamping of weights, measures, and weighing and measuring instruments in substitution for the fees specified in the First Schedule to the Weights and Measures Act, 1889, and, as from the date on which the Order in Council comes into operation the enactment mentioned in Part II. of the Schedule to this Act shall be repealed to the extent specified in the third column to that Schedule:

And whereas the Board of Trade have represented to His Majesty that it would be expedient to specify new fees to be taken in respect of the verification and stamping by Inspectors of Weights and Measures of the weights and measures in the manner set forth in the Schedule hereto:

And whereas it has been made to appear that the fees specified in the Schedule hereto are reasonable and proper:

Now, therefore, His Majesty, by virtue of the power vested in Him by the said Act, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, is pleased to direct that the fees specified in the Schedule hereto annexed shall be taken accordingly in substitution for the fees specified in the First

Schedule to "The Weights and Measures Act, 1889."

This Order shall come into operation on the 1st day of February 1905.
