Dispatches have been received from Commodore Hood, commanding his Majesty's ships and vessels in the Leeward Islands, containing a list of 33 vessels captured and recaptured by his squadron; between the 1st of January and 30th of June 1804. Among the captures are, the Egyptienne privateer (formerly frigate) of 36 guns and 250 men; the Curieux-corvette, of 16 guns and 105 men;—the Prosperine Dutch-frigate of 32 guns; Pylades corvette of 18 guns, and George schooner of 10 guns; and nine French privateers, of from one to 12 guns, and 30 to 80 men.
