DISEASES OF ANIMALS ACTS, 1894 to 1903.

The following Area is now subject to the provisions of the Swine Fever (Infected Areas) Order of 1902:—

Edinburghshire.—An Area in the County of Mid-Lothian comprising the Parishes of Cramond and Corstorphine, such parts of the Parishes of Colinton, Currie, and Ratho as he to the north of the branch of the Caledonian Railway viâ Kingsknowe, and such parts of the Parish of Kirkliston as hie within the said County (27th July 1905). The following Areas are now subject to the provisions of the Swine Fever (Regulation of Movement) Order of 1903:—

Aberdeenshire, Bunffshire, Caithness, Elgin, Forfarshire, Inverness-shire, Kincardineshire, Nairn, Orkney, Perthshire, Ross and Cromarty, Sutherland, and Zetland.—An Area comprising the Counties of Aberdeen, Banff, Caithness, Elgin, Forfar, Inverness, Kincardine, Nairn, Orkney, Perth, Ross and Cromarty, Sutherland, and Zetland; the Cities of Aberdeen, Dundee, and Perth; and the Burghs of Peterhead, Elgin, Arbroath, Brechin, Forfar, Montrose, and Inverness (20th March 1905).

Ayrshire.—An Area comprising the County of Ayr, and the Burghs of Ayr, Irvine, and Kilmarnock (23rd June 1904).
