BUCKINGHAM PALACE, December 11, 1906.

This day had Audience of The King—
 General Doctor Don Emilio Maria Terán, to present his Credentials as Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the Republic of Ecuador;
 Señor Don Daniel Muñoz, to present his Credentials as Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the Republic of Uruguay; and
 Phya Visutr Kosa, to present Phya Raja Nuprabandh's Letter of Recall and his own Credentials as Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from His Majesty the King of Siam.

WHITEHALL, December 13, 1906.

The King has been pleased to give and grant unto Kenneth Mackenzie Scott, Esq., M.B., M.Ch., His Majesty's Royal licence and authority that he may accept and wear the Insignia of the Fourth Class of the Imperial Ottoman Order of the Osmanieh, conferred upon him by His Highness the Khedive of Egypt, authorised by His Imperial Majesty the Sultan of Turkey, in recognition of his services.

Walter Risley Hearn, Esq., to be His Majesty's Consul-General for the Departments of Seine Inférieure, Calvados, Eure, and Orne, with the exception of the Town, Port, and Arrondissement of Rouen, to reside at Havre; and
 Charles Bell Child Clipperton, Esq., to be His Majesty's Consul for the Town, Port, and Arrondissement of Rouen, to reside at Rouen.

 Vivian Henry Courthope Bosanquet, Esq., to be His Majesty's Vice-Consul at Drama and Serres.

FOREIGN OFFICE, November 30, 1906.

The King has been pleased to approve of—
 M. Adrien Clément Laurent-Cochelet to be Consul-General of France at Cape Town, with consular jurisdiction in Cape Colony, British Bechuanaland, the Bechuanaland Protectorate, Basutoland and Pondoland; and
 M. Auguste Henri Dellemagne to be Consul-General of France at Montreal with consular jurisdiction in the Provinces of Quebec, Ontario, Manitoba, Nova Scotia, New Brunswick, Prince Edward Island, and the North West Territories.
