WHEREAS the Secretary for Scotland has, under the provisions of the Burial Grounds (Scotland) Act, 1855, made a Representation, stating that he has received a copy of an Interlocutor by the Sheriff-Substitute of Ayrshire at Ayr finding that the Burial Ground of the Parish of Monkton and Prestwick, situate at Prestwick, in the county of Ayr, and known as St. Nicholas Churchyard, is in a condition which is dangerous to health and offensive and contrary to decency :
