The Civil Service Commissioners, with the consent of the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, and in pursuance of the Order in Council of 22nd March 1879, as amended by Clause 21 of the Order in Council of 29th November 1898, hereby give notice that persons actually admitted before 1st July 1907 to superannuation rights in respect of the under-mentioned pensionable situations in the Naval Ordnance Depôts, other than the depôt at Woolwich, shall be exempt from the payment of fees in respect of certificates of qualification hereafter issued for those situations, viz. :—
