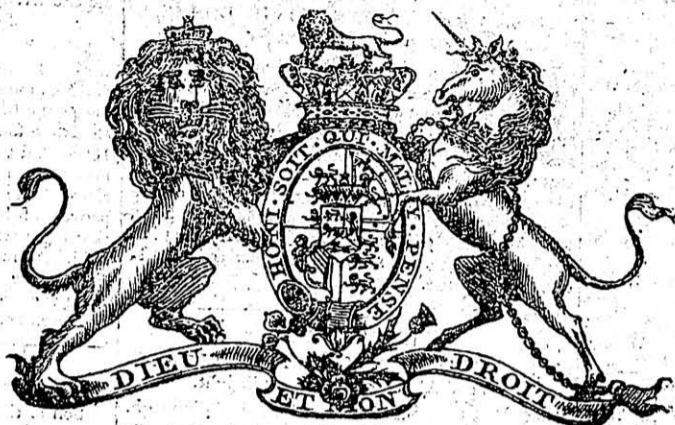

PRESENT,

The King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

Whereas information has been received that an Embargo has been ordered to be laid upon all British ships in the ports of the kingdom of Spain, within the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, together with all persons and effects on board the said ships and vessels; but that the utmost care be taken for the preservation of all and every part of the cargoes on board any of the said ships, so that no damage or embezzlement whatever be sustained: And the Right Hon. the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, the Lord Lieutenant of Ireland, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the necessary directions herein, as to them may respectively appertain.
