FOREIGN AND COLONIAL PARCEL POST.

In pursuance of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, His Majesty's Postmaster-General hereby gives notice that a Warrant, dated the 15th day of August 1908, and coming into operation on the 1st day of September 1908, has been made on his representation by the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, relating to the rates of postage on parcels to German Samoa.
