**SALMON FISHERIES (SCOTLAND) ACTS,
1828 TO 1868.**

**THE DISTRICT OF THE RIVER NESS (ANNUAL
CLOSE TIME) ORDER, 1908.**

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me, and upon application by Petition from the District Board of the River Ness, in terms of Section 9 of the Salmon Fisheries (Scotland) Act, 1868, I, the undersigned, His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, do hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Annual Close Time for the District of the River Ness shall commence on the 27th day of August and terminate on the 10th day of February, both days inclusive.
2. It shall be lawful to fish for and take salmon with the rod and line in the District of the said River Ness from the 2nd day of February to the 15th day of October, both days inclusive, in each year.
3. This Order shall take effect forthwith, and may be cited as the SALMON FISHERIES, DISTRICT OF THE RIVER NESS ORDER, 1908.
4. The Bye-law applicable to the District of the River Ness, contained in Schedule C of the Salmon Fisheries (Scotland) Act, 1868, is hereby revoked.

**THE MOTOR CARS REGULATION (BURGH OF
BROUGHTY FERRY) ORDER, 1908. Dated 26th
September 1908.**

In pursuance of the powers vested in me by Section 9, as read with Section 18 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, I, the Right Honourable John Sinclair, His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, on the application of the Town Council of the Burgh of Broughty Ferry, being the local authority of the said Burgh, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. This Order may be cited as "The Motor Cars Regulation (Burgh of Broughty Ferry) Order, 1908," and the regulations hereby prescribed shall take effect within the limits or places referred to therein on and after the respective dates at which, for the purpose of giving effect thereto, the local authority shall, in terms of Section 10 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, place notices in conspicuous places on or near such limits or places.
2. A person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour within the limits or places specified in the Schedule to this Order.
