#### MOTOR CARS.

THE MOTOR CARS REGULATION (COUNTY OF FORFAR) ORDER, 1909. Dated 28th May 1909.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me by section 9, as read with section 18 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, I, the Right Honourable John, Baron Pentland, His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, on the application of the County Council of the County of Forfar, being the local authority of the said County, do hereby make the following regulations:—

1. This Order may be cited as "The Motor Cars Regulation (County of Forfar) Order, 1909," and the regulations hereby prescribed shall take effect within the limits or places referred to therein on and after the respective dates at which, for the purpose of giving effect thereto, the local authority shall, in terms of section 10 of the Motor Car Act, 1903, place notices in conspicuous places on or near such limits or places.
2. A person shall not drive a motor car at a speed exceeding ten miles per hour within the limits or places specified in the schedule to this Order.

### SCHEDULE.

#### LIMITS OR PLACES.

#### DUNDEE DISTRICT.

VILLAGE OF WELLBANK: From a point in Luckieslap Road 20 yards north of the milestone at the cross roads at Four Mile House to a point in said road 60 yards south of the bridge over the burn from Gagie Quarry.

VILLAGE OF BIRKHILL: From a point in the Coupar-Angus Road 50 yards west of the westmost house in the village of Birkhill to a point 50 yards east of the eastmost house in said village.

#### BRECHIN DISTRICT.

VILLAGE OF EDZELL: (1) From a point in Edzell Road or High Street 50 yards south of the Dalhousie Memorial Arch to a point 50 yards south of the junction of said road or street with the road to Dunlappie.

(2) From a point in the Dunlappie Road opposite to the west boundary of the feu known as "Courseview" to the junction of said road with the High Street.

(3) From a point in Margie Road 50 yards west of the farmhouse known as "Lochside" to the junction of said road with High Street.
