PROPOSED REGULATIONS UNDER SUBSECTION 1 OF SECTION 1 OF THE ACT.

Notice is hereby given, in pursuance of the Rules Publication Act, 1893, as applied by the Rag Flock Act, 1911, that the Local Government Board for Scotland propose, on the expiration of
