PRESENT.

The King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

THEREAS the Lords of the Committee of the Privy Council on Education in Scotland, by virtue and in pursuance of the powers in them vested under Section 14 of the Education (Scotland) Act, 1908, and of every other power enabling them in that behalf, have made a Superannuation Scheme for Teachers, dated the 1st day of November 1911:-

And whereas the provisions of the said Act have been complied with and the said Scheme has been laid before both Houses of Parliament in accordance with the directions contained in the said Act:

And whereas neither House of Parliament has presented an Address praying His Majesty to withhold His consent from the said Scheme or any part thereof:

Now, therefore, His Majesty having taken the said Scheme (a copy whereof is hereunto annexed) into consideration, is pleased, by and with the advice of His Privy Council, to approve the same, and to order, as it is hereby ordered, that the said Scheme do take effect as from the 1st day of April 1912.

By the Lords of the Committee of the Privy Council on Education in Scotland.

The Lords of the Committee of the Privy Council on Education in Scotland, by virtue and in pursuance of the powers in them vested under Section 14 of the Education (Scotland) Act, 1908, and of every other power enabling them in this behalf, do make the following Superannuation Scheme for Teachers:

1. In this Scheme and except as the context or the nature of the subject may otherwise require :-

Words importing the singular number include the plural number, and words importing the plural number include the singular number.

Words importing the masculine gender include

the feminine gender.

"The Fund" means the Scottish Teachers'
Superannuation Fund established in accordance with Section 14 of the Education

(Scotland) Act, 1908. "The Department" means the Scotch Educa-

tion Department.

"The date of commencement" is the date on which the Fund shall be deemed
