## THE DISTRICT OF THE RIVER NITH (ANNUAL CLOSE TIME) ORDER, 1912.

IN pursuance of the powers vested in me, and upon application by Petition from the District Fishery Board of the River Nith, in terms of section 9 of the Salmon Fisheries (Scotland) Act, 1868, I, the Right Honourable Thomas M'Kinnon Wood, His Majesty's Secretary for Scotland, do hereby make the following Order:—

1. The Annual Close Time for the District of the River Nith shall commence on the 10th day of September, and terminate on the 24th day of February, both days inclusive.
2. It shall be lawful to fish for and to take salmon with the rod and line in the District of the River Nith from the 10th day of September to the 30th day of November, both days inclusive in each year.
3. This Order shall take effect forthwith, and may be cited as the District of the River Nith (Annual Close Time) Order, 1912.

## TRUSTEE SAVINGS BANKS LIFE ANNUITY REGULATIONS, 1913.

Notice is hereby given, under the Rules Publication Act, 1893, that it is proposed by the Commissioners for the Reduction of the National Debt, with the consent of the Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury, after the expiration of at least 40 days from this date, in pursuance of the Government Annuities Acts, 1864 and 1882, and the Savings Bank Act, 1887, to make regulations for carrying out the provisions of those Acts so far as the trustees of savings banks are concerned.
