At the Court at Buckingham Palace, the 16th day of July 1914.

PRESENT,

The King's Most Excellent Majesty in Council.

WHEREAS there was this day read at the Board a Memorial from the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, dated the 13th day of July 1914, in the words following, viz. :—

“Whereas by Section 3 of the Naval and Marine Pay and Pensions Act, 1865, it is enacted, *inter alia*, that all pay, pensions, and other allowances in the nature thereof, payable in respect of services in Your Majesty's Naval or Marine Force to a person being or having been an Officer, Seaman, or Marine therein, shall be paid in such manner, and subject to such restrictions, conditions, and provisions, as are from time to time directed by Order in Council :

“And whereas Your Majesty by Your Order in Council bearing date the 19th day of July 1912 was pleased to sanction provisional arrangements for the emoluments of Officers and others serving in the Naval Wing of the Royal Flying Corps :

“And whereas we are of opinion that these arrangements require revision in certain respects :

“We beg leave humbly to recommend that Your Majesty may be graciously pleased to sanction the proposals set forth in the accompanying schedule, to take effect as from the 1st July 1914.

“The Lords Commissioners of Your Majesty's Treasury have signified their concurrence in these proposals.

“SCHEDULE.

“I.—OFFICERS.

“1. Officers and Warrant Officers appointed to serve in the Naval Wing of the Royal Flying Corps (which will be designated the Royal Naval Air Service) to be graded and to receive pay as follows :—
