2½ PER CENT. EXCHEQUER BONDS,

THE Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury hereby give notice that, under the regulations made in pursuance of section 7 (2) of the Finance Act, 1905 (5 Edw. VII., c. 4), and published in the London Gazette of the 18th August 1905, the final drawing of the above Bonds will take place at the Bank of England on Monday the 15th February 1915, at 11. a.m. The Bonds then drawn will be paid off at par on and after the 18th April 1915. The numbers of the Bonds drawn will be published as soon as possible after the drawing has taken place.
