sole leather tanner, provided that in the event | of the said factor selling the aforesaid leather in quantities less than are contained in whole bales he may add 1d. per lb. to the price of the leather, and in all such sales the said factor shall allow discount at the rate of 2½ per cent. for payment within 30 days.

(4) No merchant or dealer of sole leather shall sell or deliver sole leather of the description aforesaid at a price exceeding the gross price at which it was sold to him by the tanner or factor of sole leather by more than $7\frac{1}{2}$ per cent., but in the case of sales of lots of less than 50 bends or their equivalent in butts an additional 21 per cent. may be

(5) No person shall purchase or take delivery of a quantity of sole leather of the description aforesaid exceeding in the aggregate 500 bends or their equivalent in butts from any individual seller during the course of any of the seven consecutive days.

(6) Each tanner of sole leather shall be supplied by the Director of Raw Materials with a code word by which each grade and tannage of leather sold by him may be identified, and every such tanner, factor, merchant or dealer in selling sole leather of the description specified above shall quote the code numbers for the particular classes of leather included on his invoice.

(7) Every such tanner or factor shall in making sales of leather of the description aforesaid obtain from the buyer a guarantee signed by him in the form set out in Schedule B to this Order that 50 per cent. of the total quantity of leather so bought shall be reserved

for sale to the repairing trade.

(8) Nothing in this Order shall be taken as permitting any person holding stocks of leather of the description aforesaid which have been purchased under guarantee for Naval or Military purposes and subject to conditions imposed by or on behalf of the Director of Raw Materials to be resold or dealt with otherwise than subject to the said conditions and for Naval or Military purposes only.
