Falling ... $\frac{4}{12}$ d. per half oz.

All made up in pieces delivered free in Dundee, less 3 per cent. discount Dundee terms. If unmade up for bags, $\frac{1}{4}$ d. per lineal yard to be allowed.

Cropping.—Prices are calculated uncropped. Cropping to be charged at the Associated Calenderers' tariff rates current at date of delivery, plus $1\frac{1}{2}$ per cent. on value of cloth for waste.

When finishing allowed, allowances to be at Associated Calenderers' tariff rates current at date of delivery.

Mangling, packing, sewing, stamping, &c., to be charged at the Associated Calenderers' tariff rates current at date of delivery.
