A PROCLAMATION.

REVOKING A PROCLAMATION, dated the twentyfifth day of June 1918, prohibiting the exportation from the United Kingdom to Switzerland of certain articles, and amending a Proclamation dated the tenth day of May 1917, as amended by subsequent Orders of Council, and by a Proclamation dated the eighteenth day of December 1918.

HEREAS by a Proclamation, dated the twenty-fifth day of June 1918, made in pursuance of Section 1 of "The Exportation of Arms Act, 1900," and of Section 1 of "The Customs (Exportation Restriction) Act, 1914," We thought fit, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, to prohibit the Exportation from the United Kingdom to Switzerland of certain articles:

And whereas it is provided by Section 2 of "The Customs (Exportation Prohibition) Act, 1914," that any Proclamation or Order in Council made under Section 8 of "The Customs and Inland Revenue Act, 1879," as amended by the Act now in recital, may, whilst a state of war exists, be varied or added to by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Trade :

And whereas it is provided by Section 2 of same is hereby, revoked, and that the Proclama-"The Customs (Exportation Restriction) Act, 1914," that any Proclamation made under and added to by subsequent Orders of Council,

Section 1 of "The Exportation of Arms Act, 1900," may, whether the Proclamation was made before or after the passing of the Act now in recital, be varied or added to, whilst a state of war exists, by an Order made by the Lords of the Council on the recommendation of the Board of Trade:

And whereas by a Proclamation, dated the tenth day of May 1917, and made under Section 8 of "The Customs and Inland Revenue Act, 1879," and Section 1 of "The Exportation of Arms Act, 1900," and Section 1 of "The Customs (Exportation Prohibition) Act, 1914," the exportation from the United Kingdom of certain articles to certain or all destinations was prohibited :

And whereas by subsequent Orders of Council, and by a Proclamation, dated the eighteenth day of December 1918, the said Proclamation was amended and added to in certain particulars :

And whereas it appears expedient to Us that the said Proclamation, dated the twenty-fifth day of June 1918, should be revoked, and that the Proclamation, dated the tenth day of May 1917, as amended and added to by subsequent Orders of Council, and by the Proclamation of the eighteenth day of December 1918, should be further amended :

Now, therefore, We, by and with the advice of Our Privy Council, hereby proclaim, direct and ordain that the said Proclamation of the twenty-fifth day of June 1918 shall be, and the same is hereby, revoked, and that the Proclamation of the tenth day of May 1917, as amended and added to by subsequent Orders of Council,
