The Secretary of State for the Home Department hereby gives notice that on the 15th August 1919 he made an Order under Section 7 of the Police, Factories, &c. (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act, 1916, to come into force on the 1st September 1919, for securing the welfare of the workers employed in factories or parts of factories in which the preserving of fruit is carried on.
