are living together, or where they are separated solely by the exigencies of the service.

"2. The Admiralty to have power to reduce or stop the allowance in the event of proved misconduct on the part of the payee and to pay the whole or a portion of it to a trustee.

"3. The allowance to be payable in respect

of Naval ratings and Royal Marines borne on the books of H.M. Ships, and Royal Marines on shore strength, and Reservists, in receipt of pay at ordinary Naval or Marine rates, and Coast Guard ratings.

"4. For the half-year, October 1920, to March 1921, to be paid in respect of all eligible men, irrespective of rating, on the following
