- (i) The registration may be cancelled if the conditions of apprenticeship are not complied with.
- (ii) An employer may employ a worker at the rates and under the conditions specified in this Schedule for Indentured Apprentices without registration for a probation period not exceeding 3 months ; but in the event of such worker being continued thereafter at his or her employment as an apprentice, the probation period shall be included in his or her period of apprenticeship.
- (iii) In cases where the number of journeymen who have been, throughout the period of 12 months prior to the date of application for registration, in the service of the employer in the branch or branches of trade to which the apprentice is bound, has been
