PROPOSAL TO VARY MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS.

In accordance with Regulations made under Section 18 of the Trade Boards Act, 1909, by the Minister of Labour, and dated 31st October 1918, the Trade Board established under the Trade Boards Act, 1918, in Great Britain for the branches of Trade specified in the Trade Boards (Hair, Bass and Fibre) Order, 1919, hereby give notice as required by Section 3 (5) of the Trade Boards Act, 1918, that they propose to vary the General Minimum Time-Rates, Piece-Work Basis Time-Rates and Overtime Rates at present fixed and set out in the Schedule to their Notice H.B. (6), dated 15th October 1921, for Male and Female Workers, the proposed variations being as shown in the Schedule set out below.

The Minister of Labour has given his consent to the issue of this Notice.
