## SECTION II.

The Minimum Rates of Wages set out in this Schedule must be paid clear of all deductions other than deductions under the National Insurance Act, 1911, as amended by any subsequent enactments, or deductions authorised by any Act to be made from wages in respect of contributions to any superannuation or other provident fund.

The Minimum Rates set out in this Schedule are without prejudice to Workers earning higher rates of Wages.

Signed by Order of the Trade Board and in pursuance of an Order of the Minister of Labour confirming the minimum rates as varied by the Trade Board and set out above, and specifying third day of July 1922 as the day from which they should become effective.

# AERATED WATERS TRADE BOARD (ENGLAND AND WALES).

MINIMUM RATES OF WAGES (AS VARIED AND FIXED) FOR MALE AND FEMALE WORKERS, EFFECTIVE AS FROM 3RD JULY 1922.

Should this date not correspond with the beginning of the period for which wages are paid by any employer who pays wages at intervals not exceding seven days, the rates become effective as from the beginning of the next full-pay period, but in any case not later than 9th July 1922.

# GENERAL MINIMUM TIME-RATES:

Male Workers of 21 years of age and over, 54s. per week of 48 hours. Female Workers of 18 years of age and over, 29s. per week of 48 hours.

Male and Female Workers below the above-mentioned ages. See Part I. of the Schedule below.

#### PIECE-WORK BASIS TIME-RATES:

All Male Workers, Is. 51d. per hour.

All Female Workers, 9½d. per hour.

OVERTIME RATES. See Part III. of the Schedule below.

The Rates in full as legally enforceable are set out in detail in the Schedule below.

Provided that a Male or Female Worker who enters the trade for the first time under the age of 18 years in the case of a Female Worker and under the age of 21 years in the case of a Male Worker and is employed on Time-Work shall until the expiry of two months' employment in the trade be paid at the rate of not less than three-quarters of the General Minimum Time-Rate which would otherwise be applicable according to his or her age under Sub-Sections (a) and (b) of this Section.
