

for all purposes under this Order without any proof thereof be presumed to be genuine and shall be taken as genuine until the contrary is proved.

7. The Registrar of Shipping at Zanzibar shall have the same powers as any Registrar of Shipping appointed under the Merchant Shipping Act, 1894, and for the purpose of enforcing the provisions of the said Act and of this Order the said Registrar shall have the same powers as by the same Act are conferred for the purposes of registration and measurement on any officer of Customs or any officer of the Board of Trade.

8. The British Resident shall with regard to the performance of any act or thing relating to the registry of a ship registered at Zanzibar, or of any interest therein, be considered as in all respects occupying the place of the Commissioners of Customs.

9. In cases where it appears to the Commissioners of Customs or to the Governor or other person administering the Government of any British possession, that, by reason of special circumstances, it would be desirable that permission should be granted to any British ship to pass without being previously registered, from any port or place in His Majesty's dominions to the port of Zanzibar, in the Protectorate of Zanzibar, it should be lawful for such Commissioners or Governor or other person to grant a pass accordingly, and such pass shall for the time and within the limits therein mentioned have the same effect as a certificate of registry.

10. Where it appears to the British Resident that by reason of special circumstances it would be desirable that permission should be granted to any British ship to pass without being previously registered from the port of Zanzibar to any port within His Majesty's dominions the British Resident may grant a pass accordingly and such pass shall for the time and within the limits therein mentioned have the same effect as a Certificate of Registry.

11. Fees not exceeding the amounts named in the Schedule to this Order shall be taken in respect of the matters mentioned in the said Schedule but the British Resident shall have power to prescribe for lower fees being taken.

12. All fees authorised to be taken under this Order shall be applied to general revenue.
