" Movement Areas " for the purposes of Part I.

of the Sheep (Double Dipping) Order of  
1920:—

*Inverness.*—(1) An Area comprising the Islands  
known as the Outer Hebrides (*except the  
islands of St. Kilda, Dune, Soay, and  
Boreray*), in the county of Inverness.

(2) An Area in the county of Inverness  
comprising the islands known as Skye or  
Inner Hebrides.

*Ross and Cromarty.*—An Area comprising the  
Island of Lewis, including the smaller islands  
adjacent thereto, in the county of Ross and  
Cromarty.
