ORDER OF THE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FISHERIES.

DATED 17TH FEBRUARY 1928.

ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND) ORDER OF 1928.

The Minister of Agriculture and Fisheries, by virtue and in exercise of the powers vested in him under the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927, and of every other power enabling him in this behalf, hereby orders as follows:—

Prohibition of Landing of Animals Shipped from Ireland.

1. Notwithstanding the provisions of the Animals (Landing from Ireland, Channel Islands, and Isle of Man Order of 1923 and of any Order amending it, cattle, sheep, goats or swine shipped from Ireland shall not, unless and until it is therewith ordered by the Minister, be landed after the date hereof at any port or place in Great Britain.

Offences.

2. Any person committing, or aiding, abetting, counselling or procuring the commission

of any breach of the provisions of this Order, is liable, on summary conviction, to the penalties provided by the Diseases of Animals Acts, 1894 to 1927.

Local Authority to Enforce Order.

3. The provisions of this Order shall be executed and enforced by the Local Authority.

Short Title.

4. This Order may be cited as the ANIMALS (LANDING FROM IRELAND) ORDER OF 1928.
