

- (d) Industrial Chemistry, Organic.
(e) Advanced Physics.

Of the subjects numbered 4 to 7 a candidate may offer any two. Candidates must obtain such an aggregate of marks in the examination as a whole as to satisfy the Civil Service Commissioners.

7 Application for permission to attend an examination must be made in the writing of the candidate, at such times and in such manner as may be fixed by the Commissioners.

8. A fee of £4 will be required from each candidate attending an examination.

The Commissioners further give notice that an Open Competitive Examination will be held in London under the foregoing Regulations, commencing on the 23rd July 1929.

Not fewer than 12 candidates will be appointed on the result of this Examination, if so many should be found to be duly qualified.

No person will be admitted to Examination from whom the Secretary of the Civil Service Commission has not received, on or before the 6th June 1929, an application, in the Candidate's own handwriting, on a prescribed form, which may be obtained from the Secretary at once.
