ALTERATION OF PARISH AREAS. PROPOSED ORDER NO. LVI.

PARISHES OF AUCHTERGAVEN AND LOGIEALMOND.

Whereas it has been represented to me by the County Council of the County of Perth that I should issue an Order under Section 51 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1889, and Section 46 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1894, annexing to the Parish of Auchtergaven that portion of the Parish of Logiealmond which lies to the north and northeast of the Shochie Burn.

And whereas, after consulting with the authorities concerned, I am of opinion that it is expedient to give effect to the said representation;

Now therefore I, the undersigned, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, do, in virtue of the powers conferred upon me by the Local Government (Scotland) Acts, order as follows:—

1. The portion of the said Parish of Logiealmond above described shall cease to form part of the Parish of Logiealmond, and shall form part of the Parish of Auchtergaven.

2. Nothing herein contained shall affect the rights of creditors or of persons having vested interests.

3. This Order shall take effect immediately for the purpose of any Order determining the contents and boundaries of electoral divisions under Section 8 (3) of the Local Government

(Scotland) Act, 1929, and on the 16th day of May 1930 for all other purposes.

PARISHES OF CALLANDER AND PORT OF MENTEITH.

Whereas it has been represented to me by the County Council of the County of Perth that I should issue an Order under Section 51 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1889, and Section 46 of the Local Government (Scotland) Act, 1894, annexing to the Parish of Callander that portion of the Parish of Port of Menteith which lies to the north of the watershed between Port of Menteith and Loch Vennachar-side.
